Activities/Responsibilities

- Responds to requests from the Pastor on any structural or material needs of the Church.
- Responsible for managing members on the committee
- Maintains contact lists of members and submits changes to the PVSC
- Plans and facilitates meetings of the committee as required.
- Coordinates the activity and involvement of committee members
- Solicits quotations for work needing to be done in the parish.
- Prepares reports for the Parish Finance Council and Pastoral Council about the repair and maintenance work needed to be done.

- Desires to serve the community and to commit time and talents to this ministry.
