Congratulations to all incoming officers and thank you to our outgoing officers.

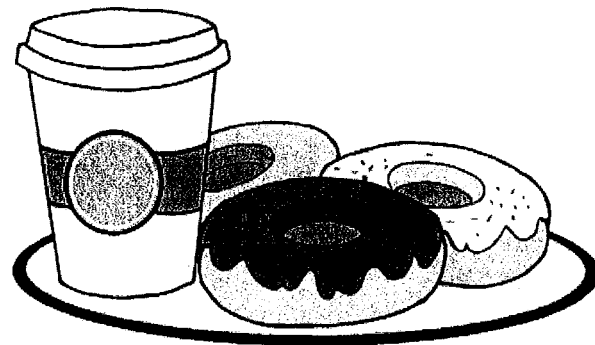
