Change of Parish Pastoral Council (PPC) Chair

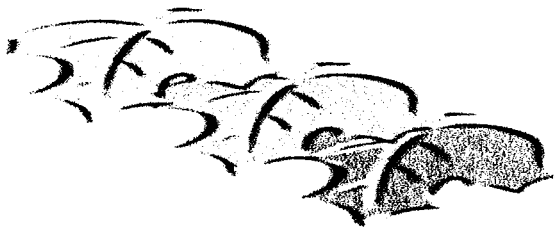

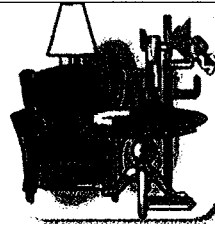


CPR & AED Training

The typography of the word UNITED expresses the idea of all together with its letters that are stretched out and bound together.

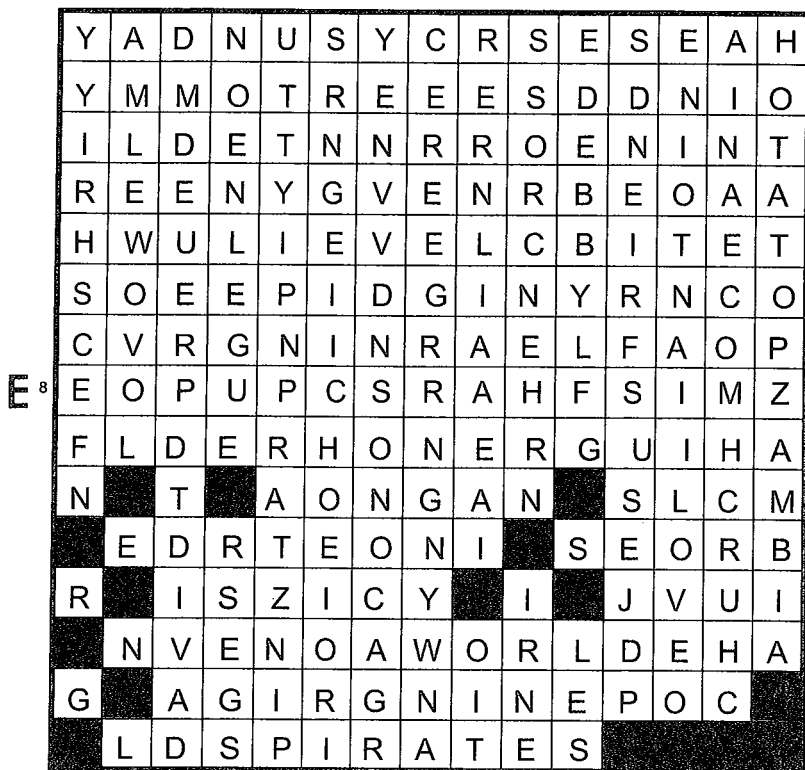
In the word LOVE: the red letter L expresses Love itself.
