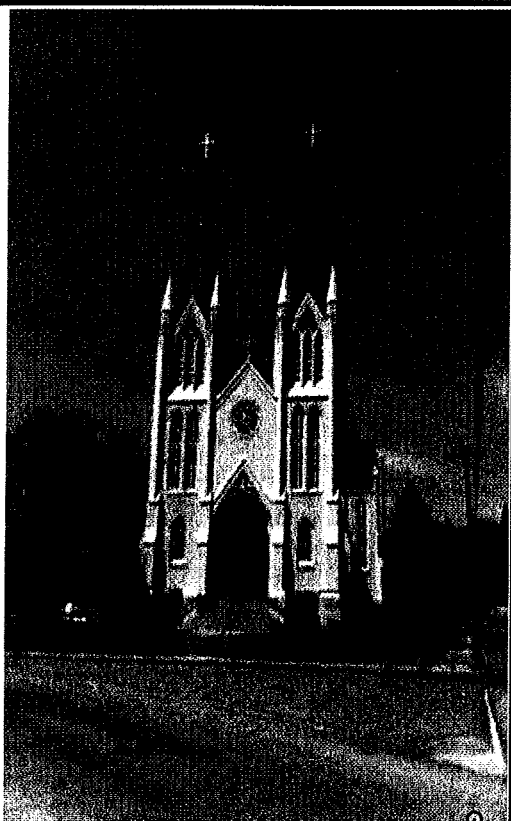

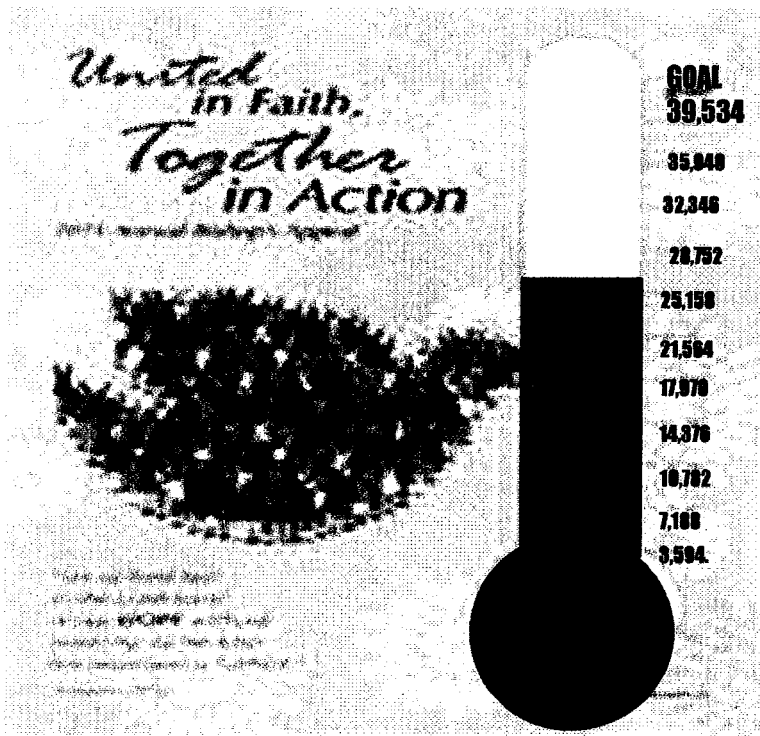

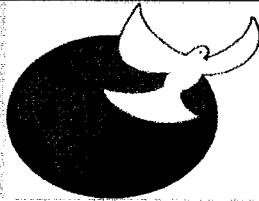

## Hospital Ministry to the Sick.

### **Important information for ALL Parishioners!!**

Please note, the hospital list, we draw names from is **no longer** available to the clergy or the volunteers because of the **Privacy Act** which protects the patients' right to decide if they want a visitation or not. **This means** the hospital staff will no longer ask your faith when you are admitted.

There are **2 ways you can help** so we can continue our ministry to the sick:

1. **Notify** the hospital admitting staff that you are Catholic.
2. If for some unknown reason, you are unable to speak for yourself, a family member or friend can notify the hospital or parish office **at any time** during your stay.
3. **Call** the parish office (403-526-2265) and let them know that you are in the hospital and would like to receive Communion and/or a visit from the Catholic community. The Eucharistic ministers will get that information and ensure that you will be on the RC list.
4. If you enter the hospital on a week-end, please call Gerry Carter directly at 403-526-7455

### **HOLY COMMUNION TO THE HOMES OR HOSPITAL**

**URGENT MATTER** for Eucharistic Ministers who are taking Holy Communion to individual homes or to Nursing Care Homes. Halina White, program Coordinator and Consultant in charge of Pastoral Care at the Calgary Diocesan office has informed us of protocol in taking Holy Communion from a priest during Mass or from the Tabernacle when Mass is not being celebrated. Anyone, who has been commissioned to take Holy Communion out **must** reverently take the Eucharist **directly to** the parishioner who has requested the Eucharist. *Do not stop for a coffee, or go shopping or take it home with you.* We are called to be obedient to what the church has recommended in respect for and in – the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. Thank you for cooperating and thank you to everyone who is presently volunteering their time in this ministry.

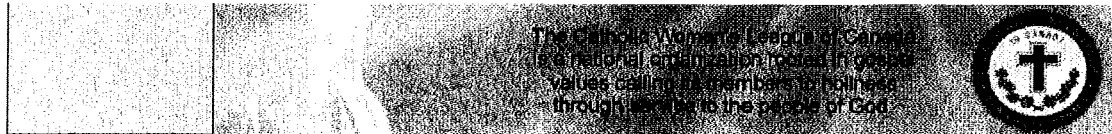
## Catholic Education Sunday

### "PORNOGRAPHY HURTS" CAMPAIGN

The CWL ladies of St. Patrick's would like to take this opportunity to thank all the parishioners for making our October campaign against child pornography such a huge success. You not only wore the white lapel ribbons that we provided, but you also signed our huge white ribbons, which will be sent to the Prime Minister in hopes that he will work with all CWL members across Canada to abolish child pornography.

We've seen an unfortunate rise in the distribution of child pornography, and also in the number of images being shared online and in the number of venues associated with child exploitation and sexual abuse crimes. Tragically, the only place we've seen a decrease is in the age of the victims. Child pornography is a form of child exploitation, and it has stolen a time of innocence from our children.

The main defense against child pornography is a close family life, a good marriage, and a good relationship between parents and their children, coupled with parental monitoring of internet use.

#### **Some Facts about Child Pornography**

(taken from various Catholic Magazines)

Pornographic websites – 4.2 million

Pornographic pages – 372 million

Daily pornographic requests – 68 million

Daily pornographic emails – 2.5 million (8% of total daily emails)

Monthly pornographic downloads – 1.5 million (35% of all downloads)

Daily child pornographic download requests – 116 000

Websites offering child pornography – 100 000

Sexual solicitations of youth made in chat rooms – 100 000

Youths who receive sexual solicitations online – 20%

Visitors to pornographic websites – 72 million annually

Let us all improve our personal behaviour and redouble our efforts to protect our loved ones and our environment from the onslaught of pornography. Thanks again for participating in our campaign!

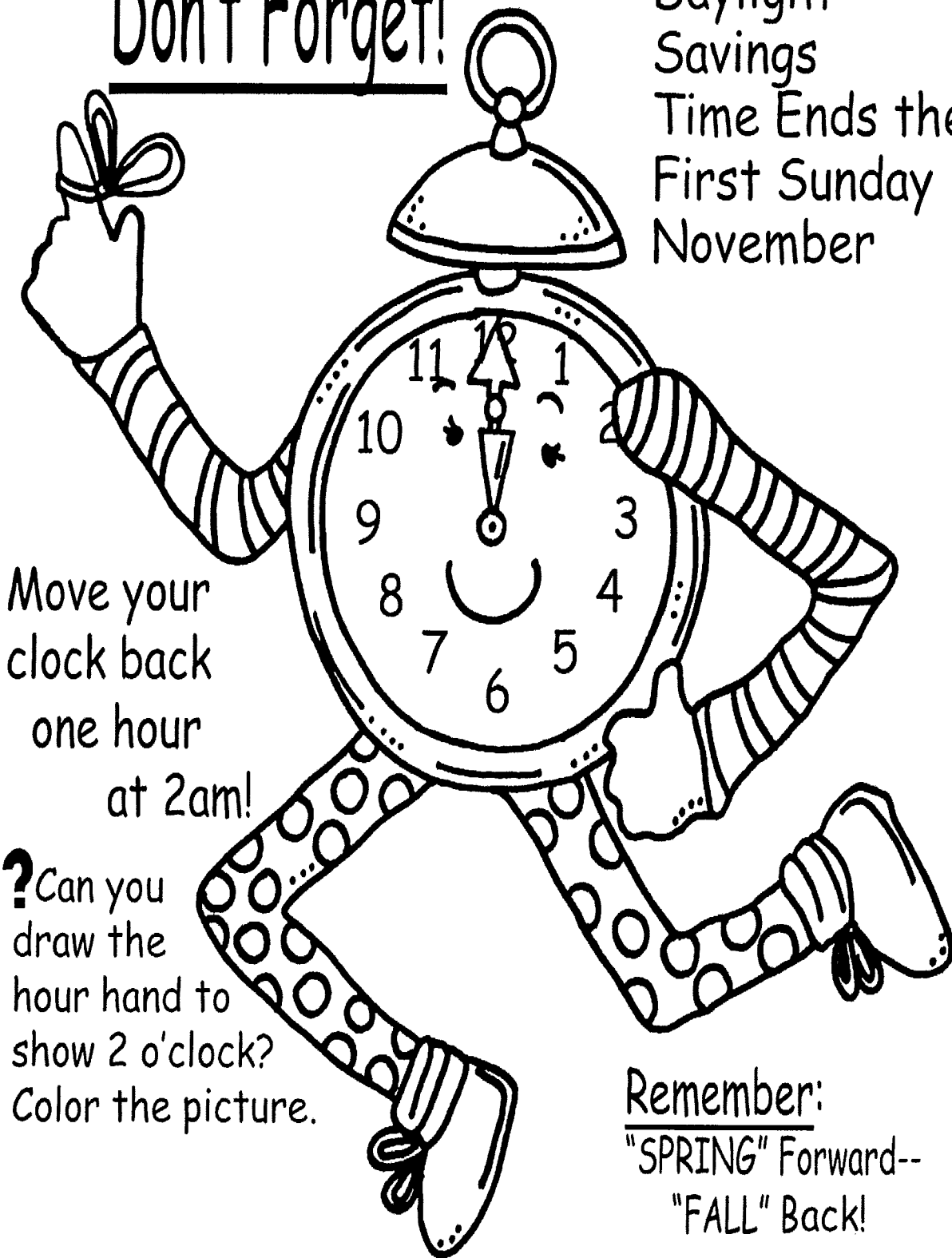
