# HOSPITAL HOLY COMMUNION MINISTRY

## A VERY IMPORTANT MESSAGE FOR ALL PARISHIONERS Regarding Holy Communion in the Hospital

First we appreciate and thank Gerry Carter and Renee Herman for picking up the list from the hospital every Friday.

- THERE HAVE BEEN SOME CHANGES MADE AT THE HOSPITAL THAT WILL IMPACT OUR HOSPITAL COMMUNION MINISTRY.
- CLERGY AND VOLUNTEERS WILL NO LONGER HAVE ACCESS TO THE HOSPITAL LIST FROM WHICH WE DRAW OUR COMMUNION RECIPIENTS every week.
- THE LIST WE WILL **NOW** BE RECEIVING IS THE "UNKNOWN" LIST - WHICH MEANS THE PATIENT(S) HAVE NOT IDENTIFIED THEMSELVES AS ROMAN CATHOLIC WHEN ADMITTED TO THE HOSPITAL AND THE HOSPITAL WILL NO LONGER ASK YOUR FAITH
- THE HOSPITAL'S RATIONALE FOR THIS IS THAT IT VIOLATES THE PERSON'S RIGHT TO PRIVACY.
- THEREFORE, OUR LIST HAS GONE FROM 20 TO 30 PATIENTS A WEEK DOWN TO UNDER 10.
- IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT IF YOU HAVE A LOVED ONE, FAMILY MEMBER OR FRIEND IN THE HOSPITAL WHO WOULD LIKE TO RECEIVE THE EUCHARIST, THAT YOU DO ONE OF TWO THINGS:
  1. EITHER CALL THE CHURCH AND LET THEM KNOW, OR ALERT THE HOSPITAL ADMITTING THAT YOU OR YOUR LOVED ONE ARE CATHOLIC.
  2. YOU ARE THEN PUT A "CATHOLIC" LIST THAT WE WILL HAVE WEEKLY ACCESS TO AND YOU AND/OR YOUR LOVED ONE WILL BE ABLE TO RECEIVE THE EUCHARIST ON SUNDAY.
