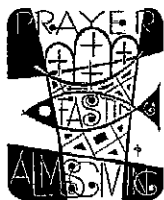

# Take Note!

## YEAR OF MERCY: PUTTING THE WORKS OF MERCY INTO PRACTICE

### Admonish Sinners

This work of mercy - "tough love," you could call it - is one of the hardest to practice in the western world today. Why? Because we live in the "I'm-OK-you're-OK" culture. As such, I have my own personal set of values, and you have your own personal set of values, and we are each free to practice those values to our heart's content just long as we do not do grievous bodily harm to others in the process.

Nine times out of ten, the end result of attempts to "admonish sinners," no matter how gently and compassionately they are performed, is that one is branded an intolerant bigot. After all, what could be a worse, more politically incorrect attitude in an "I'm-OK-you're-OK" culture than to tell others, "You're not OK: you're harming yourself and others, at least spiritually and psychologically, if not also physically and sociologically?"

The problem is that we live in a society dominated by people who have not made any real psychological or moral progress since they reached adolescence. Thus, they stumble through life with an adolescent understanding of love. To be "loved," to them, means to be affirmed in everything they want to do that does not cause anyone else (in their view) grievous bodily harm. Imagine telling someone like that, "Hey, I think you are doing something wrong; I think what you are doing can lead to your spiritual self-destruction and, perhaps, to the spiritual destruction of others, too." They'll likely complain that you are practicing intolerance and bigotry. Yet, it is to spiritually adolescent people like this - to a whole society dominated by such people - that we are called to "speak the truth in love," as St. Paul put it (see Eph 4:15), with both courage and compassion.

It is certainly not easy to do. It takes the virtue of prudence as well: finding just the right moment and just the right words, and saying them in a way that clearly affirms the human dignity of the person you are admonishing, even as they challenge him or her to fulfill his or her highest potential.

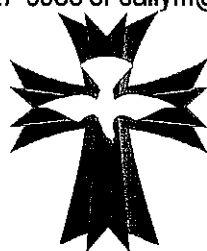

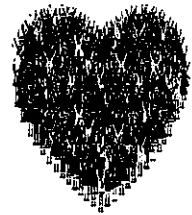

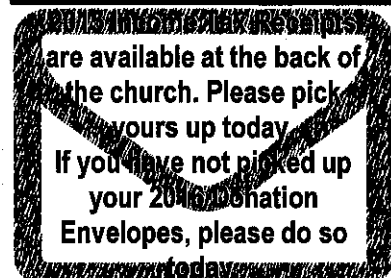

# Take Note!

## Signing Up for Direct Deposit for Donations

starring: **Larry the Penguin**



Larry regularly makes donations to the church, and would like the convenience of not writing out a cheque every week. (Penguins don't have fingers, so it's hard to hold a pen!) Luckily for him, St. Patrick's is now offering direct deposit for his donations. Larry can sign up to have a specified amount withdrawn from his bank account every week.



**That sounds great!  
How do I sign up?**

Larry already donates regularly, so his tax receipt is waiting for him at the back of the church. Stapled to that is an envelope containing a **Payor's Authorization for Pre-Authorized Debits for Personal/Household Purposes**. (If Larry didn't have a tax receipt, he could pick up that form separately at the back of the church.) He needs to fill out **BOTH SIDES** of the form, and make sure he signs it. Larry also needs to attach a **VOIDED** cheque.

**I usually divide up my donation between the Church, TIA, and St. Vincent de Paul Society. Can I still do that?**



Good question, Larry! The answer is, yes, of course! Larry can attach an empty donation envelope, and indicate on it how he wants his donation divided up.



**So, if every week I give \$5.00 to the church, \$5.00 to the Together in Action Campaign, and \$5.00 to the St. Vincent de Paul Society, I will indicate on the Authorization Form to debit \$15.00 (the total amount), and then divide everything up the way I want on the Donation Envelope.**

Exactly right, Larry! All that's left to do is return the Form, Voided Cheque, and Empty Donation Envelope. He can either bring them to us in the Parish Office, or drop them in the collection basket during Mass. Make sure they are together in a sealed envelope so they don't get lost!

**So when will the church start debiting from my account?**



That depends on when you get your form in, Larry. We will begin the Direct Deposit Program at the end of February, so to have your account debited then, please return your materials before the end of the month.

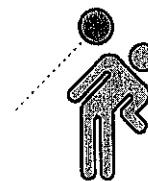

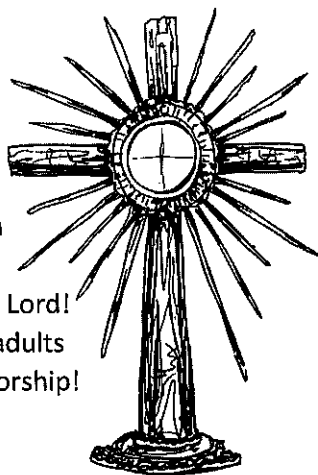
