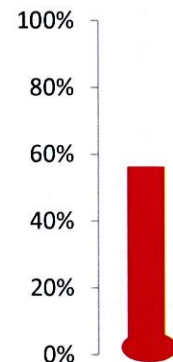

What does Jesus do when the three disciples fall to the ground in terror? Bending to touch them, he says the words that he repeats so often in the Gospel narratives: 'Do not be afraid.'...

The transcendent God who is beyond our wildest imaginings is the same God who tenderly invites each of us into an intimate relationship of love.
