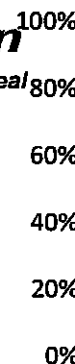

They are a rebellious house. They shall know there has been a Prophet among them.

Psalm: Psalm 123 BB pg. 109 [Eyes on God]
Our eyes are fixed on the Lord, pleading for his mercy.

2nd Reading: 2 Cor. 12: 7-10 [Suffering for Christ]
I will gladly boast of my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may dwell in me.

Gospel: Mark 6: 1-6 [God's Spirit]
A Prophet is not without honour, except in his hometown.

"A Prophet is only despised in his own country."

A prophet's job is to open people's eyes to the reality of their situation - pointing out to them the things they would rather forget or ignore. A prophet is a sort of "national conscience", always awake to situations of injustice and always speaking out about them. A prophet is commissioned to do this by God, who sends the prophet on his mission. Jesus is just such a prophet - teaching and preaching about the Kingdom of God and the best way to live. Despite the welcome his message has received elsewhere, when he comes to his hometown he is faced with rejection - such that "he was amazed at their lack of faith." It is curious that they seem to accept his wisdom, and his miracles, but because he grew up among them they cannot accept him as a teacher from God.
