Review for Readers as we continue to proclaim the Word

There are three things to emphasize in this review:

- (1) Cues
- (2) Microphone use
- (3) Preparation for scheduled Reading

A lector must be mindful of the cues that are essential to facilitate smooth conduction of the Liturgy. No one should have to wait for a lector to be present on the altar. The scheduled lectors should sit at the front of the Church to readily access the altar on cue. The scheduled lectors are expected to be in the pre and post Holy Mass procession.

Prior to all readings, the first thing is to ensure is the position of the microphone. Next is to take a deep breath and begin to proclaim. Articulation, Clarity and not rushing are the things to remember in the delivery.

*Second Reader, prior to reading at Mass, should familiarize oneself with the copy of the Announcements and the Prayers of the Faithful located next to the Workshop Book. For example, there may be pronunciations that someone could assist the lector with. Referring to the Workshop Book at the back table adjacent to the Gospel Book is the significant way to be prepared and understanding what is to be read at Holy Mass.

*Second Reader approaches the Choir Microphone immediately following the ringing of the bells. This address is for Announcements and a resounding Welcome to all present for the celebration of Holy Mass. Of note, is that the Second Reader should stand closer to the Choir microphone, which is an essential factor to know when using it.

*First Reader (unless the Deacon is present) carries The Gospel Book to place directly on the altar. No Genuflection.

*First Reader is at the podium immediately following the Collect (Opening) Prayer

*Second Reader ascends to the ambo on the altar immediately following the Cantor's singing of the Psalm. The Epistle Book is then placed on the ambo shelf following the reading. This facilitates ease for the celebrant to proclaim the Gospel.

* Second Reader (unless the Deacon is present) is at the altar by the completion of the Creed for the Prayers of the Faithful and remains at the altar until the celebrant says the Amen.

The importance of this Ministry cannot be understated. Proclaiming the Word is a vital component of the Liturgy.
