1st Reading: Jeremiah 23: 1-6 [A True Shepherd]
I myself will gather the remnant of my flock and raise up shepherds over them.

Psalm: Psalm 23 R&A pg 114 [Our Shepherd]
JR. "The Lord is my Shepherd; there is nothing I shall want."

2nd Reading: Ephesians 2: 13-18 [Access to the Father]
Christ is our peace; in his flesh he has made both groups into one.

Gospel: Mark 6: 30-34 [Jesus the Shepherd]
They were like sheep without a shepherd.

"They were like sheep without a Shepherd."

"Sheep without a shepherd." This is the simple theme of today's readings. It is interesting that Jesus' reaction to the crowd is one of pity – as he sees their great thirst for his teachings. This is, in a sense, a clear fulfilment of the prophecy we hear in the first reading, where God promises a true shepherd who will care for the people of Israel. Shepherding is a particularly suitable image of God's love and care. The dependency of the sheep on their shepherd, their wandering and drifting without someone to guide them, is also a suitable image of the people God loves. Our own age also displays sheep without shepherds - a great wandering crowd, seeking something, but not knowing what they are seeking. It is to this flock that the present day followers of Jesus are sent as shepherds..
